

Cayuga (Domestic Duck)



The Cayuga was bred in North America and is used to harsh conditions, They have a good temperament and are quiet, Cayuga ducks have a mild quack, and can only be heard very occasionally, therefore an excellent garden breed . Also, since the Cayuga is a very domesticated breed they are very obedient and most of the time docile.

The Cayuga is a very productive duck and can produce 120-150 eggs every year.

At first, the eggs will appear black/dark green but as they mature, the eggs become grey, and then slowly turn to white before they hatch.

The meat of this duck breed is very flavourful; Drakes can weigh up to 3.6 kg whereas females weigh around 3.2 kg.

Cayuga Ducks are a great choice to keep because they are so beautiful looking, they add a touch of colour to any garden.
