

Khaki Campbell (Domestic Duck)



The Khaki has been mainly developed for egg laying, is extremely agile and will lay up to 320 eggs a year: out laying most breeds of chickens.

They are a great duck for a garden and can be tamed with food and treats. They lay lovely white eggs and are just as comfortable on land as in water and are referred to as 'splashers rather than swimmers.' They are reasonably quiet birds and are excellent foragers, keeping gardens and ponds free of, slugs, snails and worms; bred as a back garden duck two females are very happy with chickens or on their own and will give a dozen eggs per week if fed well.

It is advisable to clip the khakis wings as being a light weight bird given a good wind they may just take off!! Although they are not known for flying!!

They were originally designed to be kept alongside chickens. We do not recommend any duck being housed with chickens but most breeds are happy running alongside chickens (once fully grown) sharing the same foraging areas. Being excellent foragers they are easy to keep and extremely hardy.
